Event Assistance:

- Greeting patrons as they arrive and logging attendance.
- Selling tickets and assisting with other box office duties.
- Answering patron questions regarding the exhibitions and other programming.
- Collecting tickets and assisting patrons with finding empty seats.
- Monitoring patrons and the facility during events.
- Assisting with event clean up.
