

CALL FOR WORKSHOP FACILITATORS

Indy Ldn is a multi-disciplinary artist residency in London, Ontario. As a part of the Indy Convergence network, Indy Ldn strives to create a space where diverse kinds of artists can come together and create without fear or limitations.

We are looking for active artists/educators/facilitators of the arts community in London, Ontario to lead one-off workshops during the Indy Ldn two-week-long artist residency happening in summer 2018 (exact dates TBA). Workshops can be from any discipline of the arts, ranging from music, to movement, to acting, to behind the scenes work, to business, and anything in between! Some examples of past Indy Convergence workshops include: "The Art of the 30-Minute Rehearsal", "Abstract Movement Development", "Bunraku Puppeting", "Contact and Contemplation", "Stage Combat", and many more!

Workshops will last approximately **2 hours**, and workshop facilitators will be given a small honorarium as well as funding to cover any materials costs.

5. Outline/flowsheet of the workshop structure, including approximate timing.
6. Describe what you feel the workshop participants will gain from this experience.
7. Provide a rough budget outlining any materials/props that will be needed.
8. Please provide any additional notes. (ex. Is there a maximum number of participants that you can accommodate? Are there any specific technical requirements that you would need? Any other specifics you would like us to know.)
